"We didn't really consider it because it wasn't allowed," Desoto said. "But when the decision came down from the 9th Circuit, we really began to think that this could actually be a possibility."

Until today, their story was the norm for same-sex couples in Arizona, wondering when if ever they were going to be offered the same benefits of heterosexual couples. This left a feeling of relief among them almost as strong as the joy.

"I was scared that if something happened to her, like going to the hospital, I wouldn't be able to be there for her when she needed me," Desoto said. "Or God forbid, something serious happened to me and I passed away, she wouldn't get the help she needs."

The crowd that awaited them behind Window 1 wasn't just present for the historic nature of the event. Sowers works in the clerk's office, making this an even more personal occasion in her life. Her co-workers were there to show their love at the end of a tough journey for equal rights. It also ensured she would be able to make history.

"I've worked here for 25 years," Sowers said. "So I told them to make sure we're the first


